

Cooling towers in District cooling

Stockholm Exergi AB is an energy company that is jointly owned by the City of Stockholm and Fortum OY. Stockholm Exergi produces district heating, district cooling and electricity. As the energy supplier of district cooling in greater Stockholm area *Stockholm Exergi* confirms in context of the LEED certification the following facts:

- We have no cooling towers or evaporative chillers in the cooling network that covers the area from Karolinska sjukhuset in the north down to Globen in the south and from Hornsbergs strand in the west to Sickla malls. Instead of cooling towers we use water from the nearby sea or cleaned sewage water before it's sent back to the nearby sea
- We have no cooling towers or evaporative chillers in Larsberg at Lidingö, only free cooling from the sea.
- All other networks have cooling towers
 - Kista/Akalla – uses 4-5 cooling tower cycles
 - Other networks - information is sent by request
